NO WIPES IN THE PIPES!

Wipes won't decompose... they get caught up in wastewater treatment plant screens, pumps and filters — and that costs money to clear and repair!
Just because a product claims to be “flushable” doesn't mean it belongs in our sewers.

STOP! NEVER FLUSH THE FOLLOWING:

Disinfecting/cleaning wipes
Paper towels
Rags, towels, washcloths
Towelettes
Kitty litter
Needles, syringes and other medical waste
Baby wipes
Toilet seat covers
Diapers
Feminine hygiene products
Dental floss
Mop/cleaning brush refills
Medications
Q-Tips/Cotton balls

CEASE THE GREASE!

- **Never** pour grease or food products down sink drains or into toilets.
- **Scrape** and/or wipe grease and food scraps from trays, plates, pots, pans, utensils, grills and cooking surfaces into a can or the trash.
- **Don't** run (hot) water over greasy dishes. Wipe them first with dry paper towels to remove greasy residue.
- **Never** put grease or food products down garbage disposals.

It's not a trash can!
