The goal of the Architectural Request process is to ensure that any exterior work is compliant with the FLRA Architectural Guidelines and CC&R's PRIOR to buying materials or starting work, ultimately eliminating disagreements and/or costly rework.

<p>ACC Category 1: “Like-for-like” replacements or repairs</p> <p>➤ These projects may be approved by the Board, without going to ACC</p> <p>➤</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • change or replace exterior light fixture • change, replace, or repaint front/back door OR front/back screen door • repaint exterior of townhouse Fountain Lake brown including repair & replacement of damaged siding • repaint/stain existing wood balconies/deck/railings Fountain Lake brown including repair & replacement of wood planks (no footprint change) • replace roof with approved dark brown shingles - with or without removal of skylights <p>** ALL OTHER PROJECTS MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH DESIGN DETAILS **</p>
<p>ACC Category 2: All other project/replacements</p> <p>➤ Requests must go to the FLRA Board and ACC for approval</p> <p>➤</p> <p>Process for review: Attach photos and/or scale drawings specifying all dimensions, design, color, and materials. The more information you provide, the quicker the decision from ACC. Your requests will be considered at the next FLRA Board Meeting and then forwarded to the Architectural Control Committee. The FLRA Board will contact you with approval/rejection after ACC reviews your request. Please consider attending the FLRA Board meeting in-person to present your request and address any questions.</p>
